The Center for Ministry Development promoted this mission in the spirit of the Second Vatican council by providing training, resources, and consultation for pastoral ministry and catechesis with youth and families. From 1978 to 2021, Catholic parishes and dioceses trusted CMD to provide a vision and practice for ministry rooted in Church documents, Scripture, and best practices research. Through partnership with ministry leaders, CMD strived for excellence and innovation by providing practical, field-tested ministry solutions, resources and youth programs.

History

July 1, 1978 *Northeast Center for Youth Ministry* is birthed by John Roberto, Brian Reynolds, and Rosemary Cingari. John Roberto served as Director from 1978 to 2000.

1979 *Certificate in Youth Ministry Studies* is created. Over 17,000 students participated through 2021.

Three Sites: Diocese of Camden; Diocese of Trenton; Immaculate Conception Seminary, Archdiocese of Newark

(Its original roots: Summer School at La Salle College, Philadelphia)

1980: Dioceses of Buffalo and Rochester (9 Saturdays a year) and Seton Hall University

1981: Weekend program (8 weekends over 2 years) in Atlanta and Orlando

1982: Dioceses in Iowa—Davenport, Des Moines, Dubuque, Sioux Falls

1983-1990: Thirty sites and more than 60 dioceses came on board.

1994: The Canadian Certificate in Youth Ministry Studies program was established and initiated in partnership with Canadian Ministry Services.

1995-2002: Certificate Program is provided in the Caribbean Islands, Ireland, and Guam.

2002: The Irish Certificate in Youth Ministry Studies was established and sponsored by the Redemptorist community in Ireland.

2008: The Canadian Certificate Program began to be sponsored by *the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists), Edmonton-TorontoProvince.*

2009: The Scottish Certificate in Youth Ministry Studies is launched, sponsored by the Global Education Centre and the Xaverian Fathers.

2011: The Belizean Certificate in Youth Ministry Studies is launched in partnership with the Viatorian community.

2021: Partnership with Vietnamese Religious Communities in the United States.

1985 Center for Youth Ministry Development (The name was changed to recognize the national and international scope of the organization.)

1995 Center for Ministry Development (The name was changed for a final time to acknowledge the inclusion of ministries with families, young adults, and catechesis for the whole parish community.)
